[Proposed] Order Granting Plaintiffs' Motion for Attorneys' Fees and Costs, Administrative Expenses, and Class Representative Service Awards

This matter came before the Court on a Fairness Hearing on February 5, 2024. During the Fairness hearing, the Court considered, among other things, Plaintiffs' Motion for Attorneys' Fees and Costs, Administrative Expenses, and Class Representative Service Awards. This motion is unopposed by Defendants.

Having considered the motion papers, the proposed Settlement Agreement which the Court preliminarily approved on September 27, 2023, the arguments of counsel, and all files, records, and proceedings in this action, and otherwise being fully informed in the premises as to the facts and the law,

It is hereby ORDERED as follows:

1. Class Counsel's request for an award of \$1,366,666 in attorneys' fees is approved. Having reviewed Class Counsel's application and the applicable legal authorities, the Court finds the requested amount (one-third of the \$4.1 million Settlement Fund) to be reasonable and

appropriate.

2. Class Counsel's request for litigation expenses in the amount of \$48,980.72 and

settlement administration expenses in the amount of \$106,895.23 is approved. The Court has

reviewed these expenses and finds that they are reasonable and appropriate given the nature of this

action.

3. Plaintiffs' request for a class representative service awards in the amount of \$5,000

each to Named Plaintiffs Chris Carrigan, Michael Venti, and Sylvain Yelle (\$15,000 total) is

approved. The Court finds this award to be justified under the facts of this case and consistent with

applicable legal authorities.
